**Reconnect Groups** provide a welcoming & friendly atmosphere where women can relax, meet with other women and share experiences in a safe and supportive environment.

Activities include Goal Setting, Personal Development Plans, Communicate with Confidence, Dress for Success, Connect, Get Creative, Breath Work & Yoga, Nature & Nurture and Walking Together.
